Bury Court has been described as 'somewhere between heaven and earth', and that's exactly what Luke & Becky wanted from their wedding day. This couple opted for an outdoor wedding ceremony at the Bury Court Barn, and they wanted their love story really was something out of a film.

Luke and Becky wanted their whole day to be about classical romance, so we designed the bouquets, arches, buttonholes and table decorations in romantic and pretty styles, working with seasonal flowers in fresh whites and greens, with just a few splashes of pale pink to tie into the bridesmaid's gorgeous dresses. I also supplied a range of rose gold and copper accessories, including vases and stands, for the tables to tie the theme together.

Stephen and Louise got married in late November, with a ceremony and reception held at Millbridge Court in Surrey. A restored 19th Century house, it oozes opulence and luxury with a hint of rustic wood.

To compliment the venue and the unique style of the couple, we opted for a range of sumptuous organic designs with plenty of foliage in silvers and greys, paired with rich burgundy and cream flowers and soft blue accents to draw it all together. We created table flowers to be placed down the long traditional dining table and a display that perfectly matched the 19th-century feel.

We opted for seasonal designs in a rustic arrangement but with an elegant display, using vintage brass stylings and candlesticks to match the venue's grand ceilings and fixtures. The bride being a lover of colour, the flowers themselves were a mix of vibrant pinks, purples and a pop of coral to bring life to the displays and really make them stand out.









INVESTMENT

WEDDING FLOWERS, DESIGN & SERVICES

My full wedding service starts from £1,800, and that can cover all of the basic floral arrangements you would need for a wedding. All of my prices are bespoke to your requirements, and you'll be provided with a detailed quote after a short consultation.

However, I know weddings are expensive, so I will always make suggestions on how to re-purpose your florals and arrangements throughout the day. For example, I often recommend using your church flowers as part of the arrangement for your wedding breakfast so that you get the most milage out of your flowers — and I will even be on hand during the day to move them for you!

All prices in this brochure are to give you a rough idea of my style and costs, but I always recommend booking for a coffee so that I can get to know you and your wedding plans. This way I can give you an accurate proposal and quote and include any special details in the flowers as well.



EXAMPLE INVESTMENTS

Please note I do not offer packages. No two weddings are the same, but here are a few examples.



BASIC WEDDING FLOWERS

My economy option, which includes a bridal bouquet, flower girl crowns, buttonholes, table designs and 2 large vase designs. Prices start at £1,800.





COUNTRY CHURCH
WEDDING & RECEPTION

Church weddings with a separate reception venue. Includes bridal party flowers, buttonholes, 20 church-tied pew ends, a large urn display, a milk-churn style display and 10 reception venue table designs.

Prices start at £2,900.



CIVIL CEREMONY & RECEPTION

For the civil ceremony and reception that's all in one venue. Includes bridal party flowers, buttonholes, re-use of 3 bridesmaid bouquets, 7 further bouquets for display, mantlepiece designs, table designs, and a large urn or pedestal design. Prices start at £2,300.

Perfect for outdoor weddings and marquee receptions.
Includes bridal party flowers, buttonholes, 8 table centrepieces, 2 hanging floral planks, 1 floral arch and 3 display jugs. Prices start at £3,995.

BASIC WEDDING FLOWERS

Basic doesn't have to be boring! Here is an idea of the deisgns that could be provided for you with a budget of approx £1,800. I bouquet in seasonal flowers of your choosing, along with 2 flower girl crowns and up to 10 button holes for the bridal party. For the venue florals, I can provide 2 large vase or urn designs, along with up to 8 low vase table centrepieces in the flowers of your scheme. A popular option is seasonal hand-tied vase displays, with styling including log slices and tea lights. Perfect for the bride on a budget who still wants stunning floral displays on her wedding day.

CIVIL CEREMONY & RECEPTION

If you're having a civil ceremony and reception in a barn or historic house, I can provide a full floral decoration service. This includes a tailored bridal bouquet (or 2), up to 3 bridesmaids flowers and 8 buttonholes for the bridal party. Depending on your venue I can also provide mantel piece designs, table designs and provide an additional 7 bouquets for display throughout the venue alongside the bridesmaid's bouquets. I can also style centrepieces for your tables (including extras like candles and mini pumpkins), and a large urn or pedestal designs to really capture attention.

COUNTRY CHURCH WEDDING & RECEPTION

For classical romance in a church wedding to a personal vibe in your reception venue. I can provide bridal party flowers for the bride and up to 4 bridesmaids, as well as up to 10 buttonholes for the rest of the bridal party. Your church can be adorned with traditional church-tied pew ends, a large urn display and a gorgeous milk churn style display for outside the church. At your reception venue, I can provide up to 10 table designs as well as repurpose your church flowers throughout the venue.

MARQUEE RECEPTION

If you've opted for an outdoor wedding with a marquee reception, we can style the venue and your bridal party in matching florals. For this kind of wedding, I would provide bridal party flowers, including 1 bridal bouquet, up to 5 bridesmaids flowers and 8 buttonholes. For the marquee, 10 bud-vase style table flowers and 2 hanging floral planks, along with up to 3 jugs of flowers for displaying in lounge areas and high tables. To finish it all off, 1 beautiful floral welcoming arch that's just perfect for those selfie shots!

WHEN WILL MY FLOWERS BE DELIVERED?

The exact time of delivery will be discussed with you, but I generally try to deliver your flowers as early as your venue will allow me in. I will liaise with your venue to arrange a good time for me to arrive, and I'll be there early enough to make sure it all goes smoothly!

) WILL YOU BE THERE THE WHOLE DAY?

I won't be there until the reception winds down, but I will be on site from the moment the flowers arrive until your photos are done and you're sitting down for your meal. That means I'll be on hand to arrange the flowers in the venue, help position buttonholes and move the arrangements from the ceremony room into the reception room for you.

$\bigcirc \bigcirc \bigcirc$. What happens to my flowers after the wedding?

Once your flowers are delivered, they are yours to keep. But that doesn't mean you should throw them away afterwards. Closer to the day I'll chat with you about various ways to use your flowers after your wedding — from giving them as gifts to preserving them for years to come. If I've loaned you any props, I'll go back to the venue the following day to collect them.

4. DO YOU PROVIDE PROPS?

Yes! Sometimes flowers look best when displayed in or wound around something, so I keep a wide range of props in stock to suit almost any style of wedding. If there's something very specific you're looking for, I can even go out and find it for you. I can supply vases, arches, plinths, crates, urns, or anything to do with the mechanics of the display, so it's one less thing for you to worry about!

$\bigcirc 5$. How does payment work?

After our initial consultation, your wedding date will be held for 14 days while you make a decision. If you choose to go ahead with me, you'll be asked to pay a 20% deposit to secure your date. 50% of the balance will then be due 8 weeks before the wedding, and the final balance is due 2 weeks before the wedding day. Payments can be made by PayPal or bank transfer.

()(). WHEN DO I NEED TO MAKE A FINAL DECISION?

In general, I like to get the bulk of the decisions made quite quickly – things like style, colours and number of arrangements - so that we can plan and source the flowers and props. However, I do know how difficult last-minute guests can be, so there is always room to make minor changes up to 8 weeks before the wedding.

0 how do you handle seasonal flowers?

Because flowers are incredibly seasonal, it's not always possible to get the exact flower you would like. I source my flowers from the highest quality Dutch Auction as well as the best British growers to ensure I can supply the range of florals and accompaniments I need to make your day special. I love working with British growers because their flowers have such personality to them, with their wiggles, scent and sometimes their unique imperfections adding to the 'natural' vibe. This means all of my work is highly seasonal, and I work with them to create the look you're after. We will discuss your wedding season, along with flower options for that time with a look, colour and feel to match your theme, in our consultation.
